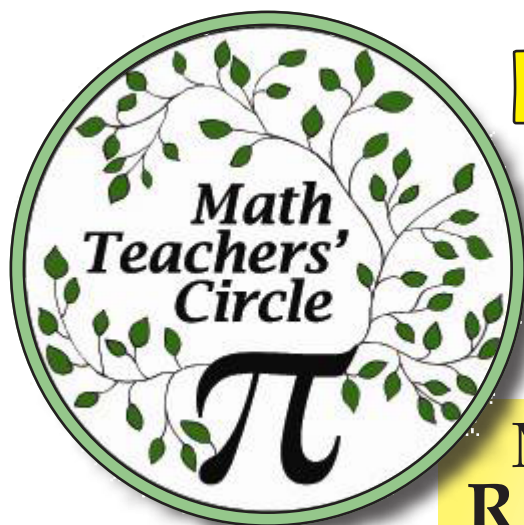




For all mid-level math teachers, mathematics professors, and mathematicians in the Mid-Hudson region.
